INTRODUCTION

www.blacknightspace.com is owned and operated by Black Night Space LLC ("Black Night Space"). To obtain our most up-to-date privacy policy notice, please visit this page often. Your privacy is very important to us, and we are committed to protecting it. This Privacy Policy describes how the Black Night Space website collects, uses, and shares your personal information whether collected through our websites, by using our products or services, by attending or signing up for our events, or by other means.

We reserve the right to update this Privacy Policy at any time, and such updates will be posted on this page and be effective immediately. For material changes, such as changes that expand the categories of personal information we collect or the purposes for which we use it, we will provide reasonable advance notice, for example by email or a prominent notice on this page, before the change takes effect. We encourage you to review this Privacy Policy periodically to remain informed.

1. Types of information we collect and why

Directly from you: If you scan your badge at an event (webinar, conference, expo) or provide your business card, we may collect your name, mailing address, email address, telephone number, job title, your organization's name, and your areas of interest. If you visit our offices, we may require you to register as a visitor and provide your name, your organization's name, your address, and proof of citizenship (including passport information). In addition, we may need to take a photograph of you. Scanning your badge at an event will provide Black Night Space with the same or similar information. If you participate in a recorded meeting, your name, image, and voice might be captured. Where applicable law permits, our offices' cameras capture images for security purposes and for crime prevention.

Note on sensitive categories: Social Security numbers and health or medical information referenced in the table below are collected only in employment, benefits administration, or vendor payment contexts (for example, new-hire onboarding, insurance enrollment, or contractor tax forms), not through general use of our website or event registration. Financial account and payment card numbers may also be collected in connection with commercial transactions (such as invoicing a customer or paying a vendor), not just general browsing. Passport and citizenship information is collected solely for in-person office visitor registration, as described above.

Through our website, we may automatically collect certain information and store it in log files. The information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, the region or general location where your computer or device accesses the internet, browser type, operating system, and other usage

information about our website, including a history of the pages you view. We use this information to help us design our site to suit your needs better. We may also use your Internet Protocol "IP" address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our website, analyze trends, track visitor movements, and gather broad demographic information that assists us in identifying visitors.

Analysis: We analyze traffic on www.blacknightspace.com in the aggregate using services such as Google Analytics and Pardot cookies, which are subject to their own Privacy Policies, which we encourage you to review. We use this information to improve your user experience and determine the effectiveness of our website. If you do not want Google to drop a cookie (_ga) in your browser, please get the Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on here: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>.

Local Storage and Cookies: We use technologies such as local storage and cookies to store an access token on your browser, which enables us to recognize you and your preferences the next time you log in. We do this specifically to enhance your experience and improve our site, products, and services. We use the following categories of cookies: (a) strictly necessary cookies required for the website and login functionality to work; (b) analytics cookies (such as the Google Analytics and Pardot cookies described above) that help us understand site usage; and (c) preference cookies that remember your settings. Most browsers let you block or delete cookies through their own settings; blocking strictly necessary cookies may prevent parts of the site from functioning. We retain cookie-derived data for the period described in Section 6 (Retention Period) below. Note that we do not respond to Do Not Track (DNT) browser signals; however, we do honor the Global Privacy Control ("GPC") signal as described in Section 10 below.

Note that in addition to the information that we collect from you directly, we may receive information about you from other sources, including third parties, business partners, affiliates, or publicly available sources.

2. How we use the information

In addition to the uses described above, we may use your personal information, sometimes in combination with non-personal information, in the following ways: to operate, maintain, monitor, and protect the security and integrity of our services. The information collected may also be used to comply with U.S. Government requirements, ensure the appropriate use of licensed Black Night Space software, provide notifications about software updates, and provide technical support. To provide access to a licensed software product, we also capture and retain acceptance records for the applicable product-specific license agreement (such as the LaunchPad License and Support Agreement), including the timestamp, your account identity, and the version of the notice you accepted. When you contact us, we keep a record of your communication to help solve any issues. If you have submitted personal information to us or have opted in to receiving materials, we may use the email address that you provided to notify you of product information and services that you requested, marketing information, events, newsletters, or product

release announcements that may be of interest to you. You can make changes to your subscription preferences at any time by visiting blacknight.space or by following the steps described in the Black Night Space correspondence that you receive. You can also unsubscribe from all email lists. We use certain personal information for system administration, auditing the use of blacknight.space, and statistical marketing purposes, as well as providing our product partners with general statistical information about our users.

3. How do we share the information

Affiliates and Acquisitions: We may share your personal information with corporate affiliates (e.g., sister companies, subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under common control). If Black Night Space becomes, or plans to become, involved in a merger, acquisition, reorganization, or any form of sale or transfer of some or all of its assets, we may share your personal information with the acquiring party, including during the negotiation stage.

Suppliers and Service Providers: We share your personal information with suppliers and Service Providers to enable such parties to perform functions on our behalf and, under our instructions, to carry out the purposes identified in this policy and those that are necessary to perform the services. This includes, but is not limited to, our IT service providers, data back-up and disaster recovery providers, our webinar service, our customer relationship management databases, our website host, our auditors, our lawyers and tax advisers, third-party consultants who provide us with support with respect to business analytics and marketing campaigns, and the providers of external venues where we host conferences. To the extent that Service Providers have guaranteed to us that they do not further collect, sell, or use your personal information, except as necessary to perform the service for which they were engaged, Black Night Space requires all Service Providers to continue to safeguard your personal information adequately. Service Providers might anonymize the personal information and use it in the aggregate.

Business Partners: If you attend an event organized or hosted by us, we may disclose your business contact details to others who attend or participate in the joint organization of that event, per your direction. You have the opportunity to opt out of such sharing at any time by sending an email to legal@blacknight.space. If we share your business contact information with our business partners, we will enter into a contract that protects your information from being shared downstream without your consent.

External websites and Social Media: Please note that blacknight.space may contain links to independent websites, products, or services, including social media features and widgets, which are hosted by third parties and are governed by their privacy practices. If you visit these sites, it is your responsibility to protect your privacy by reviewing the other parties' Privacy Policies.

Disclosures without your consent: We may share your personal information if we determine that it may be needed or requested to satisfy any applicable governmental law, regulation, investigation by public authorities, or proceeding. We may also share your personal information if we have a good-faith belief that disclosure is necessary to prevent or respond to fraud, defend Black Night Space, or protect the rights, property, and safety of Black Night Space, our customers, users, and the public.

4. Security

While no methods of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage are fully secure, and we cannot completely ensure, warrant, or guarantee the security of your personal information, we take reasonable measures to protect your information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. All personal information is protected using appropriate physical, technical, and organizational measures. We also use reasonable efforts to prevent unauthorized, third-party access to personal information that you transmit, and you agree that you do so at your own risk. If we are required by law to inform you of any breach of personal information, we will do so in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

5. Data Integrity and Access to Your Information

We rely on you to update and correct your personal information. Some of our websites allow you to modify your account profile. If you want to access the information that is collected about you or believe that any of the information needs updating, correcting, amending, or deleting, please sign in to your profile to edit it at any time or contact us at legal@blacknightspace.com. You may also contact us at the aforementioned address to access the personal information that may not be accessible from your account. We will correct our records upon verification of the requested change. We may decline to process frivolous requests, requests that jeopardize the privacy of others, or extremely impractical requests, or when allowed by law.

6. Retention Period

Typically, we retain your personal information for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this policy unless longer retention is required or permitted by law. As general guidance: account and transaction records are retained for the duration of our relationship with you plus seven (7) years for tax and audit purposes; event-registration and visitor-log records are retained for three (3) years; marketing-preference and cookie-derived data are retained for two (2) years from your last activity, or until you opt out, whichever is sooner; and license-acceptance and export-compliance records (such as the timestamp, account identity, and notice version accepted at first login to a licensed product such as LaunchPad) are retained for approximately five (5) years, consistent with U.S. export control recordkeeping expectations. We may also decide to delete your data sooner if we believe it is incomplete, inaccurate, or no longer needed. When we delete your personal information, it will be removed from our active database, but it

may remain in archives where deletion is not practical or possible. Furthermore, we may keep your information as needed to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and/or enforce any agreements. If you elected to receive marketing communications from us, we retain information about your marketing preferences for a reasonable duration from the date that you last expressed interest in our content, products, or services. We retain information derived from cookies and other tracking technologies for a reasonable duration from the date that such information was created.

7. Children Under 13

Black Night Space does not knowingly or intentionally collect personal information from children under the age of 13. If it comes to our attention that you are under 13, we will terminate your account and take reasonable steps to delete the personal data that you have shared with us. You may also contact us to request deletion if you believe we have inadvertently collected information about a child under 13.

8. Notice to EU/UK/Swiss Users

This section applies to you only if you are in the European Economic Area ("EEA"), the United Kingdom, or Switzerland.

→ Permitted Purposes for Processing Information

We process your personal information for a variety of permitted purposes, including: Contractual Reasons, where it is necessary to perform our contract with you or to begin contract negotiation, whether for our products or services, for employment engagement or application, to become our customer, or to perform a contract we have with you; Legal Obligation, where it is necessary for compliance with legal obligations, whether it is to carry out denied party screening, due diligence, to perform a pre-hiring check, to comply with export control laws, anti-bribery laws, or corruption; Legitimate Business Interest, where the processing is in our legitimate interest and not overridden by your data protection interests, whether to ensure compliance with our internal policies, security and business continuity, to improve business processes, training and webinars, advertising, marketing and public relations, to organize corporate events or conferences, or to protect, manage, and improve our websites; Consent, where you provide us your consent, whether it is to deal with your inquiries or requests to obtain more information about our company, to the extent required by law, consent for advertising, marketing, and public relations.

→ International Transfer of Information

Your personal information is processed in the United States and other countries where we have offices, servers, and resellers, where privacy laws may be less stringent than those in your country, and where the government, courts, or law enforcement may be able to access your information. By submitting your personal information to us, you agree to the transfer, storage, and processing of your information. Where possible, Black Night Space takes steps to treat personal information

using similar privacy principles to those that apply pursuant to the law of the country in which we first received your information. With respect to transfers originating from the EEA to the US and other countries, we have implemented Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission, as well as other appropriate solutions as required and permitted by Art. 13(1)(f), 46 and 49 of the GDPR. Black Night Space may be required to disclose personal information in response to lawful requests from public authorities, including to meet national security, law enforcement, or other public-interest requirements.

→ Your Rights

If you are in the EEA, you have the following rights with respect to your personal information, under specific circumstances: access to your personal information; rectify inaccurate or incomplete information or request it to be erased; ask us to move, copy, or transfer your personal information back to you or another; object to the processing of your personal information for marketing purposes; withdraw consent if we are processing your personal information solely based on consent; ensure that any significant decisions affecting you are not made purely by automated means based on an online profile, with the opportunity to challenge the decision; and complain to a supervisory authority about our privacy practices.

9. Other International Users

Black Night Space is headquartered in the United States, and blacknightspace.com is hosted in the United States. If you are an international visitor, you should be aware that by providing your personal information, you are: (i) permitting the transfer of your personal information to the United States, which does not have the same data protection laws as the country in which you reside; and (ii) permitting the use of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

10. Notice to California Resident Users

This section applies to you only if you are a natural person residing in California, pursuant to the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (together, the "CCPA"). Upon authentication of your identity, under specific circumstances, you may have the right to: request the categories and specific pieces of personal information being collected, the categories of sources for the personal information we collected about you, how the data is being used, if the information is disclosed or sold, and the categories of third parties with whom we share the personal information; request that your information not be sold or shared per the definition of the CCPA; request deletion of personal information, subject to certain exceptions; and not

be discriminated against because you exercised any of your consumer rights.

****Sensitive Personal Information.**** In certain contexts described in Section 1 above, such as employment, benefits administration, commercial or vendor payment transactions, and in-person office visitor registration, we may collect Social Security numbers, financial account and payment card numbers, health or medical information, or passport and citizenship information, which are "Sensitive Personal Information" under the CCPA. Where applicable, you have the right to limit our use and disclosure of Sensitive Personal Information to what is necessary to perform the services you have requested or as otherwise permitted by law. To exercise this right, submit a request using the contact information below.

****Global Privacy Control.**** We honor the Global Privacy Control ("GPC") signal, where technically detectable from your browser, as a valid request to opt out of the sale or sharing of your personal information for the browser or device on which it is set.

→ Exercising your Rights

California Residents can submit a verifiable consumer request to us to exercise their rights by emailing us at the contact information below. You can only make a request twice within 12 months. The verifiable consumer request must provide sufficient information to reasonably verify your identity (or that of an authorized representative) and to understand, evaluate, and respond to it properly. We will not provide you with personal information if you cannot verify your identity within a reasonable time period, and will close the case of your request. You are free to reopen a case if you are ready to verify your identity. Making a verifiable consumer request does not require you to create an account with us.

→ Response and Timing

We endeavor to respond to your request within forty-five (45) days of its receipt. If we require more time (up to 90 days), we will inform you in writing of the reason and the extension period. If you have an account with us, we will deliver our written response to that account. If you do not have an account with us, we will deliver our written response by mail or electronically, at your option. We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable consumer request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will explain why and provide a cost estimate before completing your request.

→ Opting out

You have the right to direct us not to sell or share your personal information at any time. You may exercise this right by enabling the Global Privacy Control in a supporting browser, as described above, or by submitting a request to us by emailing legal@blacknightsspace.com. We may disclose your personal information to our business partners as explained above. If you previously opted in to the sharing of your personal information, you can opt out of future sharing at any time. Once you make an opt-out request, we will wait at least twelve (12) months before asking you to reauthorize the sharing of personal information. However, you can change your mind and opt back in to sharing your personal information at any time by sending us an inquiry at the same address. You do not need to create an account with us to exercise opt-out rights.

11. Other California Privacy Rights

Where legally permitted, this notification will be made via email, post, or telephone.
